Protecting hematology patients in Polish regional hospitals

Polish regional hospitals have recognized the need for protecting patients from infections by providing ultrapure air in patient rooms.

Genano has delivered a total of over 150 air purifiers to regional hospitals responsible for hematology and oncology.

The Department of Hematology at the **Provincial Specialist Hospital Copernicus** in the city of Lodz is one of the long-time users of Genano air purifiers.

High enough hygienic conditions could not be reached without additional air purification. Therefore Genano units are utilized as an additional system for maintaining a high air hygiene level in rooms with immunosuppressed patients, describes the technical department of the hospital.

These patients have reduced resistance to infection because of a recent **bone marrow transplantation.**
